## Know The Amount and Type of Shade

# The Degree of Shade Varies From Light Shade to Total Shade

Spend some time in your garden observing the area. Which way does the sun come from, how many hours of sunlight a day reach the area?

#### There are different levels and types of shade;

- Dappled Shade is when there is some light that comes through the leaves of the tree.
- Partial Shade is usually three to six hours of sun each day. Preferably morning or early afternoon.
- Full shade is normally less than three hours of sunlight each day.
- Deep shade means little to no sun throughout the day.
